Severe Weather Spotter Training Summer session  
will be taught by Thomas Meyer, NOAA.

The Spotter team is a volunteer spotter network, which provides real-time weather information year round to forecasters at the National Weather Service in Boulder, Colorado. You will learn how to identify various cloud and storm features, which may produce severe weather; including large hail and tornadoes. Once you have been trained, you will be given a spotter number and guidelines on how to report. Weather reports from spotters will help save lives and property during the years to come. The spotter team is an essential part of the warning decision process of the National Weather Service!
