Professional Requirements

The applicant must have:

- Professional education or technical diploma in rural, and/or civil construction.
- Capacity to supervise a construction projects with a minimum of 3 years working experience in construction and supervision on construction site.
- Good accounting and budget keeping knowledge
- Skills in assessment, preparation of technical drawings or estimates are an advantage.
- Good knowledge of written and spoken English
