Printing & Painted Paper Weaving

AM Session – 9AM- Noon

Monoprinting is known as the most painterly method of printmaking techniques. The main characteristic of this type of printmaking is that no two prints are alike. Monoprinting spontaneously combines printmaking, painting and drawing. This class will teach the techniques of monoprinting; ink application, design application, paper selection and preparation, and pulling prints by using the hand or printing press method. In between the various steps, students will prepare painted paper for a unique weaving project. Students will complete at least 5 finished prints and a weaving. Materials included.

Drawing Studio PM Session – 1-4PM

With a minimum of materials, anyone can start to draw. Students will learn and practice the elements of drawing and design by combining basic geometric shapes to draw everyday

objects. Drawing a building with accurate perspective, capturing light and shadow, drawing plein air and representing middle, fore, and backgrounds, will be demonstrated and practiced. Materials needed: drawing pad larger than 9x12, 2 number 2 pencils sharpened, and an eraser.

Using techniques such as collage, painting and stamping, students will fill their pages with vibrant imagery. Watercolor from Within

Join nationally acclaimed watercolor artist Barbara Nechis for this 5-day workshop at The Snowflake Inn in Jackson. Her objective in teaching a workshop is to introduce the participants to her thought process in constructing a painting. By learning how she thinks as she demonstrates various watercolor techniques, students receive tools to stimulate their creative imagination to produce original designs in their own personal statements. A different method or idea will be demonstrated each day showing students how to construct original paintings from both source material and the imagination. Students may work with abstract or realistic forms. Daily demonstrations and critiques leave ample time for painting and individual assistance. Critiques will approach problem solving on the premise that there is always a solution that can turn an unsuccessful painting into a successful one.

MWVAA CLASS POLICIES

Registration

Registration is accepted up to one week prior to class start date. Class size is limited. All classes are filled on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Payment

Tuition and fees must be paid in full at the time of registration by cash, check, Visa or MasterCard. Registration is not complete until payment is received. If you need to send a check by mail, we will hold your registration for 5 days until payment is received. Tuition will not be prorated. It is the individual's responsibility to attend all classes.

Confirmation

You are officially registered for a class when your payment and completed registration form are received. You will receive confirmation and materials list (if the class has one) by email or mail.

Refunds

Withdrawal from a class more than 14 days prior to the start of the class will result in a tuition refund less a \$10 administration fee. If withdrawal is less than 14 days prior to the start of the class and the spot can be filled, tuition will be refunded less the \$10 administration fee. If the spot cannot be filled, there is no refund. All refunds will be in the form of a check. There are no refunds for missed classes. Memberships purchased at the time of registration are nonrefundable.

Cancellation of Classes

The MWVAA reserves the right to cancel any class that does not meet minimum enrollment. Students will receive notification of the cancellation and have the choice of a full refund or credit toward a future class. In the case of bad weather, all Mt Washington Valley Arts Association classes will be cancelled when SAU 9 cancels classes or closes school early. When in doubt, please call 603-356-2787 for a recorded message. When classes are cancelled due to bad weather, instructor illness or conditions beyond our control, the cancelled classes will be rescheduled.

Discounts

Members receive a discount on all classes. In order to receive the Member's discount, membership must be current through the duration of the class. Membership dues may be paid at the time of registration.
