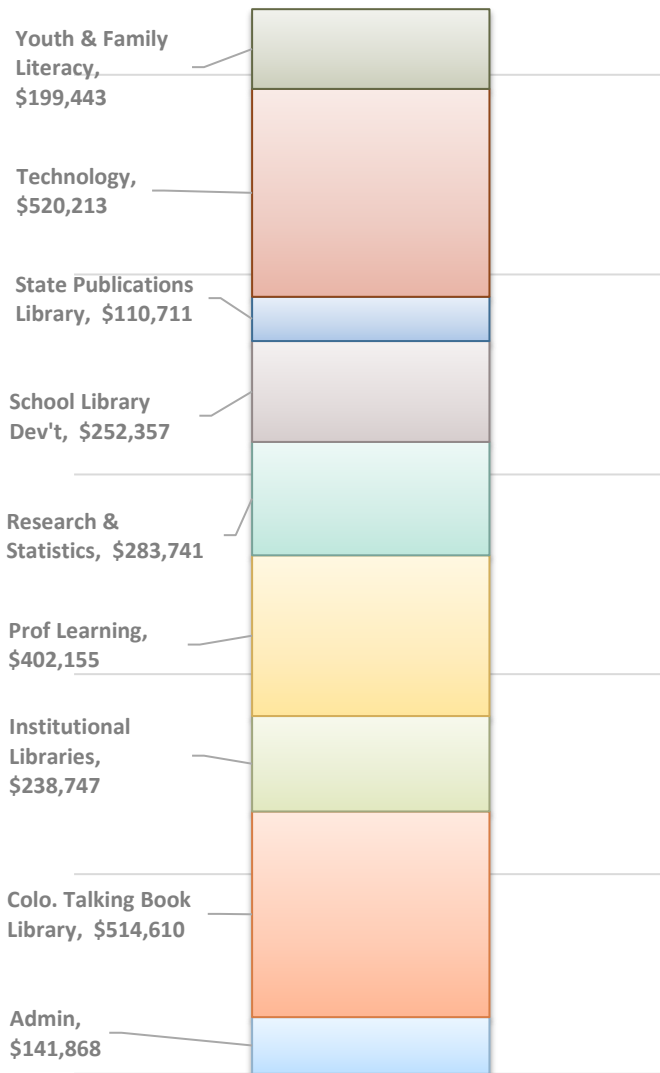


How IMLS Is Used in Colorado

IMLS is the main funding for 40+ Colorado library services and programs, yet costs less than ONE postage stamp per person!

Colorado receives \$2.7 million from IMLS for LSTA (Library Services and Technology Act), roughly 2/3 of the State Library's operational total. State funds make up the other 1/3.

Losing IMLS eliminates or severely reduces more than 40 services used by Colorado libraries and the public!
