

Choo Choo Scoot Extras FAQs:

What are the Choo Choo Scoot Extras? The are activates surrounding the Choo Choo scoot - an extra ride and camping on Friday and Saturday before the Choo Choo Scoot.

How do I sign up? No sign up is necessary. Just show up at the Friday meet up, or contact Rick Fletcher (503-539-9148) for directions.

Do I have to camp on both Friday and Saturday to ride participate in the extra rides on Saturday? Nope, this a very casual event. Come out for just Friday, just Saturday camping or for the full deal. This is for fun – there are no rules.

Do I need to reserve a spot or register. Nope. Just show up at the Bomber restaurant 13515 SE McLoughlin Blvd Milwaukie OR at 6:15 PM on Friday August 22, 2008 with your camping gear. If you can't make it to the meet up just give Rick Fletcher a call at 503-539-9148 for a map and directions to our campsite.

What is the minimum speed or CC requirement for this ride? It would be good if your scooter could reach 45 MPH.

Where will we be camping? We will be at the Kober Celebration Center. It is a private family park held in a member's family. It is not open to the general public, so if you aren't riding out with the group, contact Rick Fletcher for a map and directions.

Will there be a support vehicle to carry camping gear? Yes, if you don't want to carry your own gear there will be a support vehicle. Contact Rick Fletcher for an equipment drop.

How often will fuel be available? Frequently. Fuel will not be a problem.

What do I need to bring? Your camping gear, cash for meals not provided and a few bucks to chip in for group meals.

What food is provided? Friday night we will eat out. Saturday night we will dine on pork ribs smoked on site, potato salad, etc. As we are a small group we will make decisions at the campsite. We will have access to refrigeration and cooking faculties.

What are the campgrounds like? Showers and flush toilets are available.

Will we have a campfire? Yes
