OFFICIAL ENTRY FORM AND RULES

- RULES:** The following rules for the tournament will be used. These rules will be interpreted solely by the Tournament Committee and all decisions are final.
- TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE:** The Tournament Committee shall consist of four (4) members of the Thousand Hills Bass Club and one (1) non-member.
- ELIGIBILITY:** Tournament open to all, 16 years or older, who have paid entry fee and have a valid Missouri Fishing License. Entrants under 16 years of age must be accompanied by an adult 21 years of age or older.
- ENTRY FEE:** Entry fee will be \$50 per boat. Late entry fee of \$60 per boat applies to all entries received subsequent to five days prior to tournament date. No late entries accepted after 6:00 a.m. morning of tournament.
- DEPARTURE:** Boats will be assigned starting position by random drawing of entries received prior to late entry deadline.
- TACKLE & EQUIPMENT:** Fishing with rod and reel only. Only artificial baits or lures may be used. Pork style baits are allowed. No trolling is allowed.
- BOATS AND MOTORS:** Lake rules apply. For Thousand Hills tournament only, all boats must have a City Sticker and boats in excess of 90 h.p. will be allowed to operate motor at idle speeds only, pending permission to do so is received from the City.
- SAFETY & SPORTSMANSHIP:** All boating safety regulations must be observed. PFD jackets must be worn during takeoff. No alcoholic beverages are permitted in any boat during the tournament.
- PERMITTED FISHING LOCATIONS:** Fishing permitted on entire lake, except within 50 yards of another contestants boat at anchor with trolling motor raised.
- LIVE WELL CHECKS:** All contestants must check in at tournament headquarters prior to the take off and attend the pre-tournament meeting. All boats must participate in live well check prior to departure.
- WEIGH IN:** Five (5) fish per boat may be weighed in per day. Dead fish will be assessed a 1 lb. Penalty. Only bass over 15" will be weighed, all short fish presented at weigh in will be assessed a 1 lb. Penalty and loss of fish. All ties will be broken by coin flip. All boats not back at the weigh in site by 2:30 p.m. may be disqualified.
- BIG BASS POT:** \$10 per boat big bass pot is optional. 100% collected will be paid out. Only one big bass weighed per boat.
- PROTESTS:** Protests must be filed in writing with the tournament committee within 10 minutes of the conclusion of the weigh-in each day.
