

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SABLES-SPANISH RIVERS

BYLAW NUMBER 2013 - 22

Being a Bylaw to Designate the Date and Locations
on Which a Reduced Load Period Shall Start and End

WHEREAS Subsection 7 of Section 122 of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.H8, as amended provides that:

The municipal corporation or other authority having jurisdiction over a highway may by bylaw designate the date on which a reduced load period shall start or end and the highway or portion thereof under its jurisdiction to which the designation applies;

AND WHEREAS the reduced load period is deemed necessary for the protection of highways in the Corporation of the Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers;

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The provisions of subsections 1-4 of Section 122 of the Highway Traffic Act apply to the following areas during the period from the 1st day of March to the 15th day of June, inclusive in each and every year, while the appropriate signage is erected. Council may, by bylaw, extend the restriction date in any given year.
 - i) all roads and streets within the Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers
 - ii) Caddel Road from Toronto Street to #616 Caddel Road
2. Exceptions to the restriction in #1 above, include
 - i) all streets in the (town) of Massey
 - ii) that portion of Gagan Road from Highway 17 leading to civic address #26 Gagan Road, in order to accommodate the business of Roll #4-22005;
 - iii) that portion of Birch Lake Road from Highway 17 leading to civic address #11 Birch Lake Road, in order to accommodate the parking of heavy vehicles in the township yard;
 - iv) that portion of Caddel Road from Highway 17 leading to #616 Caddel Road, in order to accommodate access to an Industrial zoned property;
 - v) that portion of George Street south of Main Street within the (town) of Webbwood.
3. The Public Works Director of Operations, in consultation with Council, shall determine if road conditions warrant the removal of the load restriction prior to the 15th day of June in any year.
4. Any person violating the provisions of this Bylaw shall be subject to the penalties provided in Section 125 of the Highway Traffic Act and all such penalties shall be recoverable under Part III of the Provincial Offences Act.
5. The provisions of this Bylaw become effective when appropriate signs have been erected in accordance with the regulations under the Highway Traffic Act.
6. This Bylaw shall repeal Bylaw 99-17.
