Hard News:

T: the Divine Feminine is on the prowl and on the march!

- Just being able to say that yesterday Michelle Obama and Oprah winfrey are going to run for Pres and VP gives [us all goose bumps!]

 - Put a Circle of support around **Serbia** – worst floods in their country in over 100 years – worse than Katrina; completely out of nowhere it came! Have to evacuate people with helicopters, and want boats from other countires so they can rescue people that way.

Stanford had divested all investments in coal companies! That is stunning – the students did it!!! And we never needed to use coal at all – and "clean coal" is a fallacy

Turkey – the people put profit over safety: the president of Turkey did not like what one student said to him so he slapped her across the face; and another member of his party were kicking the heaven

out of another student. And they kill journalists

Egypt: there are 4 journalists from Al Jazeera in prison; one has been on a hunger strike for 117 days; they tried to announce he was not on a hunger strike – trying to force feed him! And the other 3 have had all kinds of court visits

Current financial situation world-wide

- The ability to continue the situation up - \$141 billion worth of bonds bought by Belquim and they have no money, and it was uncovered that the US Fed fixed it to make it look less – the exposure is so radical and everything is coming down so fast.

Russia: the gender issue is a horror story, **also in China** – tens of thousands of girls being trafficked there!

- 40 million average - girls women that are molested, abused, raped from babies all the way up on the US: it is systemic; all has to do with the idea of greed for money over true values of respect and honour, respect for the divine feminine

Segregation: Brown vs Board of Education became law in 1948 and 60 years later, there is worse segregation than then – and it has to do with inequality

- The story covered a couple of families: in one family, father Mexican, mother was black – and they had a child
 - mother's father lived in the next county a much better off county; and the couple lived in the county next door: this is a philadelphia story
 - the little girl spent lots of time with her grandfather; at one point, the couple was not getting along so the mother moved in with her father and the little girl went to a much better school - schools in Philly are segregated and not safe.
 - then the couple got back together and the mother wanted the little girl to finish her school year in grandpa's county because she was getting a good education; the parents are registered in the one county, and the girl in another
 - all of a sudden, the police showed up and wanted to put the parents in jail for 7 years – they were charged with a grand felony and charged \$10,000 as well for the education of the daughter;
 - this is still being litigated! It is **intentional to keep the slavery rule:** you do not get to teach a girl to read or write – that is still the attitude – yet **this is being exposed openly**
-
- T was in the middle of such a thing all of her life: has 2 children who are mulatto and a 3rd who lived with T when she was only 2, and who came from another situation:
 - the colour of the skin is more important than anything else in such neighbourhoods.

Kansas City, Missouri – the doctor in charge of the executions; it was discovered that he had about 20 charges again for all kinds of offences: turns out he is dyslexic and mixing the chemicals used to execute prisoners – he assessed if it was working by looking at the grimaces on the face!

Carlsbad, CA – the fire there is 95% contained now; San Marcos, San Diego county: 50% contained – very different from being able to announce the fire is out – have to traverse the entire area to be sure all is out. One area is 20,000 acres; the larger area is 47,000 acres

- This has to do with **fire-nados** – looks like a tornado, but it's a fire – because the land is so full of drought, and the land underneath is so hot; means the underground heat which stays in the ground after other fires & has been re-ignited due to the dry material on the land that has no moisture
- 145 km winds / 73 mph winds; now a shift in direction so cooler temperatures coming in from the ocean - not good for people's lungs, but the firefighters need to wear masks all the time.

John McCain – now calling for a total overhaul of the VA – 47 documented cases of death of men not seen

- Bernie Sanders: need to extend Medicare for everyone; the program's overhead is only 3%
- It used to be a 40% overhead – the insurance companies hate Obamacare because they lost so much money

- **The new regime** will be about working for love
 - Talking about a social income for everyone on the planet; there is enough for everyone to have a good life: organic food, a home that is efficient with no externalities: no fossil fuels; good water.
 - Right now it looks like wizards but to get to the the other side and dealing with people who have no intention of changing the way things are done is the challenge



Caller: 1 year anni of his brother passing; **Ri on the astrology tomorrow:** Venus square Jupiter, Venus being feminine, feeling energy; Jupiter being in Cancer is an emotional energy for all of us: helps us to get in touch with our feelings on things – as we think of those who passed, know they are progressing too!

Ri: and there was a T square then with Uranus in Aries and part of a Cardinal Cross present then too; each of these discoveries involved astronomers doing their calculations to determine where the planets might be as they did not have very good telescopes – took them a while to find it, based on their calculations.

Speaking of [diversity in the newsroom](#), yesterday marked the end of a 50-year-plus, daily media career which is as legendary as it is groundbreaking. That is why my letter this week goes to the Grande Dame of Media who helped open the doors for so many women.

Dear Barbara Walters,

It's me, Melissa.

[Your send-off](#) on Friday's "The View" brought out the likes of former first lady and Secretary of State Hillary Clinton, actor Michael Douglas, and Oprah. And while it was nice to see the uber-famous come out and toast your career, it was really lovely to see salutes from the [25 women broadcasters](#), from every major network – including NBC's own [Savannah Guthrie](#), [Tamron Hall](#), and [Hoda and Kathie Lee](#) – whose careers are among the many you've influenced.

It is particularly fitting since your talents have [graced every major network since 1961](#) – when you moved from local TV to the big time at NBC's "Today" as a researcher and writer. It was at NBC where you lobbied for the first of your "big gets" – with first lady Jacqueline Kennedy. You were chosen to travel as part of the press corps with President Nixon on his historic trip to China.

And because of your skill and tenacity, you would go from being known as the "Today ' girl" to earning the official title of "Today" host in 1974 – and won your first Daytime Emmy the next year, in '75.

In 1976, you made history by becoming the first woman to co-anchor a network evening news program when you moved over to ABC. That was the same year you moderated the presidential debate between Jimmy Carter and incumbent president Gerald Ford – and started the first of a series of Barbara Walters specials, where you would redefine "getting the get" and conducted the first joint interview with the Israeli prime minister and the

Egyptian president.

When you joined ABC's "20/20," your "gets" kept getting bigger, when you exclusively interviewed former president Richard Nixon in 1980. And your two-hour exclusive interview with Monica Lewinsky in 1999 became the highest-rated news program ever broadcast on a single network. The list doesn't stop there: Thatcher, Gadhafi, Castro, just to name a few. In 2000, you smashed the glass ceiling when you reportedly renewed your contract with ABC News for \$12 million, making you the highest-paid host in history.

But it was what you did in 1997 that serves as an example of your efforts to have women front and center: you created "The View," a space that allowed five women to talk about politics, family, and careers so wildly successful that it is fast approaching the 20-year mark.

You made it cool to be fearless in an industry that is male-dominated. You made it cool to be boss. But most importantly, you made it cool to be authentically yourself. While you are not about to go off into the sunset, you are about to take a well-deserved rest. But before you go, as a woman who has benefited from the doors you've opened: Thank you.

2014, May 17 60 years after Brown v. Board, inequality in America's birthplace grows

In the six decades since the Supreme Court found that segregated schools were unconstitutional and inherently unequal in the landmark 1954 ruling of Brown v. Topeka Board of Education, classrooms in many of America's hometowns have undoubtedly grown diverse in previously unthinkable ways.

Focusing in on racial segregation in schools

The white and colored-only signs that had been affixed above water fountains and public accommodations have long since been knocked down. Black and white professional athletes play alongside one another. And a country that had once barred African-Americans from voting elected a black man as president.

But while the Supreme Court's striking of school segregation changed the social and political dynamics of schooling America's children, it's arguable that 60 years later, students in public schools in all corners of the country are more segregated now than they were a generation ago – in some cases, more so than when the court decided Brown.

The vast majority of American students still attend schools where most students look like them and come from similar socio-economic backgrounds. The typical black student attends a school where 49% of their classmates are also black, 28% are white, 17% are Latino, and 4% are Asian-American. The statistics for Latino students cuts largely along the same lines. The average Latino student is enrolled at a school where 57% of his or her classmates are also Latino, 25% are white, 11% are black, and 5% are Asian.

About 15% of black students attend what Professor Gary Orfield, co-director of the Civil Rights Project at UCLA, calls "[apartheid schools](#)," in which 99% to 100% of their classmates are non-white.

But the most pronounced lack of diversity is found in schools where the typical white student attends. About 73% of their classmates are white, 12% are Latino, 8% are black, and 4% are Asian.

Look back: **60 years since Brown v. Board of Education**

The decision shook the country to its core, defying the fundamentals of the country's most ardent and longstanding manifestations of racism – the legal,

The long shadow of segregation not only stretches across the southern states where blacks had historically endured the most dehumanizing forms of racism. Across the country, in cities like Chicago, Detroit, New York and Philadelphia, there remains deeply divided school systems. New York, the heart of the liberal northeast, has the most segregated public schools in the nation, according to a report authored by Orfield called [“Brown at 60.”](#)

In New York and three other states – Illinois, Maryland and Michigan – more than half of all black students attend schools that are 90% or more non-white.

According to the report, in 2009 black and Latino students in New York had the highest concentration of “intensely-segregated public schools” with less than 10% white enrollment. These students had the lowest exposure to white students and the most uneven distribution with white students across its public school system. But the separation was most pronounced in New York City, which the report noted was home “to the largest and one of the most segregated public school systems in the nation.

In neighboring states the segregation is nearly as pronounced. In New Jersey nearly 50% of all black students attend uber-segregated schools. In Pennsylvania that number is about 46%.

“With the milestone of the 60th anniversary of the Brown decision, some may believe that the scarring from racial apartheid in this country has faded, that racial integration has been achieved, and that racial disparities in education have been removed,” Leticia Smith-Evans wrote this week in Education Week. “The truth is that public schools remain racially segregated, and that racial and ethnic disparities in education continue. The ultimate goal of Brown v. Board of Education of ending a separate but equal system thus remains an ideal.”

Philadelphia, America's birthplace, is one of a few major cities where the racial demographics skew more or less equally among blacks and whites. But the equality mostly ends there.

Black students in old, hard-scrabble black neighborhoods in North, South West and West Philadelphia mostly attend a handful of hyper-segregated schools with 90% to 100% minority-majority school populations. Schools in

these communities have grown more segregated.

“Sixty years ago, these schools were still mostly black, but there was a segment of white students in these schools, the schools were fairer,” said Leroi Simmons, a longtime community and education advocate in Philadelphia’s Germantown section. “You could go from a public school into Temple University or into Penn State. Now the kids come out and have to get remedial education just to go to community college.”

“These schools are not moving toward equity, they are moving further away from equity,” Simmons said.

It’s not only black and Hispanic students who’ve been isolated from their white peers. While many Asian students have found a steady path through some of Philadelphia’s best public and private schools, many others, including more recent immigrants or English language learners, are crammed into crowded, resource-starved mostly minority schools.

“I think people have this idea that these Asian kids are all at the magnet schools,” said Helen Gym, a founder of Parents United for Public Education. Many of them, she said, are literally “refugees dumped” into some of the city’s most challenged schools.

The lingering segregation in America’s public schools can largely be attributed to segregation in our neighborhoods. Americans by and large live in relatively homogeneous neighborhoods, often drawn along invisible boundaries demarcated by access to quality healthcare, education and employment.

What's causing racial segregation in schools?

The segregation of Philadelphia’s schools is compounded by a funding crisis that has gutted schools in poorer communities that for years have been clamoring for more funding and resources. But instead of bolstered resources, education officials have disinvested in public education.

In [Philadelphia](#), as well as a handful of other major cities, [officials in recent years have shuttered dozens of public schools, destabilizing thousands of mostly black students.](#)

“In Chicago and Philadelphia, Newark and Washington, DC, we’ve seen time and again that the schools forced to close are made up of predominantly African-American and Latino students,” said Randi Weingarten, president of the American Federation of Teachers. “Not only does this harm the students, who have to walk miles through unsafe neighborhoods or spend hours on the bus to get to school, it destabilizes entire communities by removing what has been an anchor and a hub often for generations.”

Over the summer, the Philadelphia school district shuttered more than two dozen public schools. The vast majority of them were located in predominately black neighborhoods on the historically black, north side of the city. Straining under the weight of \$1 billion in state education cuts, more than 4,000 teachers were laid off. Many schools don’t have assistant principals, full-time nurses or counselors.

“The heart of North Philly. They were the hardest hit and these were 98%, 99% black schools,” said Leroi Simmons, a longtime school advocate. “It was devastating. It ripped the heart out of many of the neighborhoods.”

Most would agree that there is no great advantage to black students simply sitting next to a white classmate, the same as sitting next to a white diner eating a burger wouldn't make the black woman next to him full.

"But there is a huge advantage to being in a middle-class school where most of the kids are going to go to college and almost everybody is going to graduate and you've got a class of other students you can learn from," Orfield, with the Civil Rights Project, [said](#).

Sherrilyn Iffil, president and director of the Counsel of the NAACP Legal Defense and Educational Defense Fund, recently wrote that "the quality of a school remains largely dependent on its students' race and socio-economic status."

"We should also recognize the pragmatic reality that housing integration may be the most foolproof way to ensure the equitable allocation of public services and development dollars for black children and families," Iffil [said](#). "Schools cannot perform in isolation; they need healthy communities with adequate housing, jobs, safe streets, and political institutions that are inclusive. In most inner cities, we have failed on every one of those essential requirements."

6:33 P.M. CDT

MRS. OBAMA: Thank you, guys. Thank you so much. Wow! (Applause.) Look at you guys. (Applause.) All right, you all rest yourselves. You've got a big day tomorrow. I want you guys to be ready.

It is beyond a pleasure and an honor, truly, to be with you here today to celebrate the class of 2014. Thank you so much for having me. I'm so proud of you guys. (Applause.) Days like this make me think of my own daughters, so forgive me if I get a little teary. You guys look great.

We have a great group of students here. We have students from Highland Park High School. (Applause.) We have Hope Street Academy students here today. (Applause.) Topeka High School is in the house. (Applause.) And of course, we have Topeka West High School in the house. (Applause.)

Tomorrow will be a big day for all of you. You all have worked so hard, I know -- I can tell. You've come so far. And as you walk across that stage tomorrow to get your diploma, know that I'm going to be thinking of you all. I am so proud of you all and all that you've achieved thus far.

And you have got so many people here who are proud of you tonight. Your families are here, your teachers and counselors, your principals, your coaches, everyone who has poured their love and hope into you over these many, many years. So, graduates, let's just take a moment to give a round of applause to those folks, as well. Tonight is their night, too. Yes! (Applause.)

Now, I want to start by thanking Lauren for that amazing introduction. (Applause.) Yes, indeed. Well done, Lauren. I want to thank a few other people here -- of course, Secretary Sebelius. As you know, my husband and I are so grateful for all that she has done, her wonderful service. (Applause.) And I'm so glad that she and her family could join us tonight.

And of course, I want to recognize Congresswoman Jenkins, Governor Brownback, and Mayor Wolgast, as well as Superintendent Ford, School Board President Johnson, and all of your great principals -- Principals Carton, New, Noll and Wiley. (Applause.) Yay!

And finally, to our fantastic student speakers -- Alisha, Rosemary and Noah -- just hearing your backgrounds makes me feel like an underachiever, so thank you so much for your remarks about Brown vs. Board of Ed.. I know Noah is coming. You have approached this issue past, present and future.

And I think it's fitting that we're celebrating this historic Supreme Court case tonight, not just because Brown started right here in Topeka or because Brown's 60th anniversary is tomorrow, but because I believe that all of you -- our soon-to-be-graduates -- you all are the living, breathing legacy of this case. Yes. (Applause.)

I mean, just look around at this arena. Not only are you beautiful and handsome and talented and smart, but you represent all colors and cultures and faiths here tonight. (Applause.) You come from all walks of life, and you've taken so many different paths to reach this moment. Maybe your ancestors have been here in Kansas for centuries. Or maybe, like mine, they came to this country in chains. Or maybe your family just arrived here in search of a better life.

But no matter how you got here, you have arrived at this day together. For so many years, you all have studied together in the same classrooms, you've played on the same teams, attended the same parties -- hopefully you behaved yourselves at those parties. (Laughter.) You've debated each other's ideas, hearing every possible

opinion and perspective. You've heard each other's languages in the hallways, English, Spanish and others, all mixed together in a uniquely American conversation. You've celebrated each other's holidays and heritages -- in fact, I was told that at one of your schools so many students who aren't black wanted to join the black students club that you decided to call it the African American Culture Club so everyone would feel welcome. Way to go. (Applause.)

So, graduates, it is clear that some of the most important parts of your education have come not just from your classes, but from your classmates. And ultimately, that was the hope and dream of Brown. That's why we're celebrating here tonight, because the fact is that your experience here in Topeka would have been unimaginable back in 1954, when Brown v. Board of Education first went to the Supreme Court. This would not be possible.

As you all know, back then, Topeka, like so many cities, was segregated. So black folks and white folks had separate restaurants, separate hotels, separate movie theaters, swimming pools, and, of course, the elementary schools were segregated, too. So even though many black children lived just blocks away from their white schools in their neighborhoods, they had to take long bus rides to all-black schools across town. So eventually, a group of black parents got tired of this arrangement -- and they decided to do something about it.

Now, these were ordinary folks. Most of them were not civil rights activists, and some of them were probably nervous about speaking up, worried they might cause trouble for themselves and their families. And the truth is, while the black schools were far away, the facilities were pretty decent, and the teachers were excellent.

But eventually, these parents went to court to desegregate their children's schools because, as one of the children later explained as an adult, she said, "We were talking about the principle of the thing."

Now, think about that for a moment. Those folks had to go all the way to the Supreme Court of the United States just to affirm the principle that black kids and white kids should be able to attend school together. And today, 60 years later, that probably seems crazy to all of you in this graduating class, right? You all take the diversity you're surrounded by for granted. You probably don't even notice it. And that's understandable, given the country you have grown up in -- with a woman Governor, a Latina Supreme Court Justice, a black President. (Applause.)

You have seen Latino singers win Grammys, black coaches win Super Bowls. You've watched TV shows in -- characters of every background. So when you watch a show like the "The Walking Dead," you don't think it's about a black guy, a black woman, an Asian guy, a gay couple and some white people -- you think it's about a bunch of folks trying to escape some zombies, right? Period. (Laughter.)

And then when some folks got all worked up about a cereal commercial with an interracial family, you all were probably thinking, really, what's the problem with that? When folks made a big deal about Jason Collins and Michael Sam coming out as gay, a lot of kids in your generation thought, what is the issue here? (Applause.) And if someone were to say something racist on Twitter, well, I imagine that many of you would tweet right back, letting them know that's just not cool.

You see, when you grow up in a place like Topeka, where diversity is all you've ever known, the old prejudices just don't make any sense. Seems crazy to think that folks of the same race or ethnicity all think or act the same way -- because you actually know those folks. They're your teammates, your lab partner, your best friend. They're the girl who's obsessed with the Jayhawks but loves computer science programming; the guy who loves the Wildcats and dreams of being an artist. (Applause.) That's the world you've grown up in.

But remember, not everyone has grown up in a place like Topeka. See, many districts in this country have actually pulled back on efforts to integrate their schools, and many communities have become less diverse as folks have moved from cities to suburbs.

So today, by some measures, our schools are as segregated as they were back when Dr. King gave his final speech. And as a result, many young people in America are going to school largely with kids who look just like them. And too often, those schools aren't equal, especially ones attended by students of color which too often lag behind, with crumbling classrooms and less experienced teachers. And even in schools that seem integrated according to the numbers, when you look a little closer, you see students from different backgrounds sitting at separate lunch tables, or tracked into different classes, or separated into different clubs or activities.

So while students attend school in the same building, they never really reach beyond their own circles. And I'm sure that probably happens sometimes here in Topeka, too. And these issues go well beyond the walls of our schools. We know that today in America, too many folks are still stopped on the street because of the color of their skin -- (applause) -- or they're made to feel unwelcome because of where they come from, or they're bullied because of who they love. (Applause.)

So, graduates, the truth is that Brown vs. Board of Ed. isn't just about our history, it's about our future. Because while that case was handed down 60 years ago, Brown is still being decided every single day -- not just in our courts and schools, but in how we live our lives.

Now, our laws may no longer separate us based on our skin color, but nothing in the Constitution says we have to eat together in the lunchroom, or live together in the same neighborhoods. There's no court case against believing in stereotypes or thinking that certain kinds of hateful jokes or comments are funny.

So the answers to many of our challenges today can't necessarily be found in our laws. These changes also need to take place in our hearts and in our minds. (Applause.) And so, graduates, it's up to all of you to lead the way, to drag my generation and your grandparents' generation along with you.

And that's really my challenge to all of you today. As you go forth, when you encounter folks who still hold the old prejudices because they've only been around folks like themselves, when you meet folks who think they know all the answers because they've never heard any other viewpoints, it's up to you to help them see things differently.

And the good news is that you probably won't have to bring a lawsuit or go all the way to the Supreme Court to do that. You all can make a difference every day in your own lives simply by teaching others the lessons you've learned here in Topeka.

Maybe that starts simply in your own family, when grandpa tells that off-colored joke at Thanksgiving, or you've got an aunt talks about "those people." Well, you can politely inform them that they're talking about your friends. (Applause.)

Or maybe it's when you go off to college and you decide to join a sorority or fraternity, and you ask the question, how can we get more diversity in our next pledge class? Or maybe it's years from now, when you're on the job and you're the one who asks, do we really have all the voices and viewpoints we need at this table? Maybe it's when you have kids of your own one day, and you go to your school board meeting and insist on integrating your children's schools and giving them the resources they need.

But no matter what you do, the point is to never be afraid to talk about these issues, particularly the issue of race. Because even today, we still struggle to do that. Because this issue is so sensitive, is so complicated, so bound up with a painful history. And we need your generation to help us break through. We need all of you to ask the hard questions and have the honest conversations, because that is the only way we will heal the wounds of the past and move forward to a better future. (Applause.)

And here's the thing -- the stakes here simply couldn't be higher, because as a nation, we have some serious challenges on our plate -- from creating jobs, to curing diseases, to giving every child in this country a good

education. And we know -- we don't even know where the next new breakthrough, the next great discovery will come from.

Maybe the solution to global warming will come from that girl whose parents don't speak a word of English, but who's been acing her science classes since kindergarten. (Applause.) Maybe the answer to poverty will come from the boy from the projects who understands this issue like no one else. So we need to bring everyone to the table. We need every voice in our national conversation.

So, graduates, that is your mission: to make sure all those voices are heard, to make sure everyone in this country has a chance to contribute.

And I'm not going to lie to you, this will not be easy. You might have to ruffle a few feathers, and believe me, folks might not always like what you have to say. And there will be times when you'll get frustrated or discouraged. But whenever I start to feel that way, I just take a step back and remind myself of all the progress I've seen in my short lifetime.

I think about my mother, who, as a little girl, went to segregated schools in Chicago and felt the sting of discrimination. I think about my husband's grandparents, white folks born and raised right here in Kansas, products themselves of segregation. (Applause.) Good, honest people who helped raise their bi-racial grandson, ignoring those who would criticize that child's very existence. (Applause.) And then I think about how that child grew up to be the President of the United States, and how today -- (applause) -- that little girl from Chicago is helping to raise her granddaughters in the White House. (Applause.)

And finally, I think about the story of a woman named Lucinda Todd who was the very first parent to sign on to *Brown vs. Board of Education*. See, Lucinda's daughter, Nancy, went to one of the all-black schools here in Topeka, and Mrs. Todd traveled across this state raising money for the case, determined to give her daughter -- and all our sons and daughters -- the education they deserve. And today, six decades later, Mrs. Todd's grandniece, a young woman named Kristen Jarvis, works as my right-hand woman in the White House. She is here with me today. (Applause.) She has traveled with me around the world.

So if you ever start to get tired, if you ever think about giving up, I want you to remember that journey from a segregated school in Topeka all the way to the White House. (Applause.) I want you to think about folks like Lucinda Todd -- folks who, as my husband once wrote, decided that "a principle is at stake," folks who "make their claim on this community we call America" and "choose our better history."

Every day, you have the power to choose our better history -- by opening your hearts and minds, by speaking up for what you know is right, by sharing the lessons of *Brown v. Board of Education* -- the lessons you all learned right here in Topeka -- wherever you go for the rest of your lives. And I know you all can do it.

I am so proud of all that you've accomplished. This is your day. I am here because of you. And I cannot wait to see everything you will achieve in the years ahead.

So congratulations, once again, to the class of 2014. I love you. Godspeed on your journey ahead. Thank you, all. God bless you. I love you. (Applause.)

Third dimensional reality is the lowest density (frequency) which a human expression of consciousness may experience. There are many side effects of the old 3D reality, including the illusion of linear time, the inability to perceive higher dimensions, and spiritual amnesia where the memory of past lives, experiences in other dimensions, and connection to the rest of the Universe is forgotten. GRAHAM HANCOCK is the author of the major international bestsellers *The Sign and The Seal*, *Fingerprints of the Gods*, and *Heaven's Mirror*. His books have sold more than five million copies worldwide and have been translated into 27 languages. His public lectures, radio and TV appearances, including two major TV series for Channel 4 in the UK and The Learning Channel in the US - *Quest For The Lost Civilisation* and *Flooded Kingdoms of the Ice Age* - have put his ideas before audiences of tens of millions. He has become recognised as an unconventional thinker who raises controversial questions about humanity's past.

It is a roller-coaster intellectual journey through the back streets and rat runs of history to uncover the traces in architecture and monuments of a secret religion that has shaped the world.

In 2005 Graham published Supernatural: Meetings with The Ancient Teachers of Mankind, an investigation of shamanism and the origins of religion. This controversial book suggests that experiences in altered states of consciousness have played a fundamental role in the evolution of human culture, and that other realities - indeed parallel worlds - surround us all the time but are not normally accessible to our senses.

"Senior Ninth Circle members include Jorge Bergoglio and Joseph Ratzinger, so-called popes of the Church of Rome, Archbishop of Canterbury Justin Welby, two British High Court judges, at least one Catholic bishop in Canada, senior government ministers in Belgium and England, and members of the British, Dutch and Belgian royal families" stated a news release from the Prosecutor's Office today.

"The most recent gatherings of the Ninth Circle occurred in the crypt of Caernarfon Castle in Wales, and within a subterranean vault beneath Marie-Reine-du-Monde Roman Catholic cathedral in Montreal, Canada. At least two of the primary defendants were identified at these recent gatherings, where children under five years of age were ritually killed. The next major conclave of the Ninth Circle at the Montreal cathedral, at 1085 Rue de la Cathédrale, is scheduled for August 15, 2014."

In response to this startling evidence, the five Court judges adjourned the trial proceedings today to allow the Prosecutor's Office to issue a call for special deputies to take immediate action to stop the murderous rituals of the Ninth Circle.

As Kevin Annett, special assistant to the Prosecutor, describes,

“I was awoken after midnight by a call from Brussels, alerting me to the Prosecution’s demand that Special Deputies be immediately sworn and prepared to take direct action to stop the Ninth Circle’s murder of children. And they will be deputizing other men and women to form Direct Action Units to enforce the standing arrest warrants against criminals like Joseph Ratzinger and Elizabeth Windsor. We can only protect our children by tracking down and stopping those who are raping and killing them, starting with the sick monsters known as the Ninth Circle.”

Offers to assist in such direct action against the Ninth Circle have already been received from policemen and politicians in Europe, and local sheriffs and active service marshals and soldiers in America.

2014, May 13 British Spies Face Legal Action Over Secret Hacking Programs

The United Kingdom's top spy agency is facing legal action following revelations published by *The Intercept* about its involvement in secret efforts to hack into computers on a massive scale.

Government Communications Headquarters, or GCHQ, has been accused of acting unlawfully by helping to develop National Security Agency surveillance systems capable of covertly breaking into potentially millions of computers and networks across the world.

In [a legal complaint](#) filed on Tuesday, the London-based civil liberties group [Privacy International](#) alleges that the hacking techniques violated European human rights law and are not subject to sufficient safeguards against abuse. The complaint cites a series of details contained in a [report published by The Intercept in March](#), which exposed how GCHQ was closely involved in the NSA's efforts to rapidly expand its ability to deploy so-called "implants" to infiltrate computers.

GCHQ and the NSA have developed an array of the sophisticated surveillance implants, according to documents from NSA whistleblower Edward Snowden, with each of the spy tools tailored for a different purpose. Some are used to compromise large-scale internet networks so that the spies can sweep up private data as it is passing through them. Others infect specific computers with malicious software that effectively gives the agencies total control of a target's machine – enabling them to take covert snapshots using its webcam, record audio using its microphone, log what is being typed on the keyboard, collect data from any removable flash drive that is connected, and snoop its Web browsing history.

Privacy International argues in its [21-page legal complaint](#) that the hacking tactics are more intrusive than more traditional eavesdropping methods, and that, if left unchecked, they could amount to "one of the most intrusive forms of surveillance any government has conducted":

In allowing GCHQ to extract a huge amount of information (current and historical), much of

which an individual may never have chosen to share with anybody, and to turn a user's own devices against him by coopting them as instruments of video and audio surveillance, it is at least as intrusive as searching a person's house and installing bugs so as to enable continued monitoring. In fact, it is more intrusive, because of the amount of information now generated and stored by computers and mobile devices nowadays, the speed, ease and surreptitiousness with which surveillance can be conducted, and because it allows the ongoing surveillance to continue wherever the affected person may be.

The case is the latest in a [string of actions](#) against GCHQ in the United Kingdom following the Snowden disclosures. But it is the first to focus specifically on the legality of hacking techniques used to infiltrate computers and spy on communications. It has been lodged with the U.K.'s [Investigatory Powers Tribunal](#), a special judicial body that handles complaints about the conduct of spy agencies.

Eric King, head of research at Privacy International, said in [a statement](#) on Tuesday that GCHQ's hacking programs were "done under a cloak of secrecy without any public debate or clear lawful authority," adding that "unrestrained, unregulated government spying of this kind is the antithesis of the rule of law and government must be held accountable for their actions."

A GCHQ spokesperson declined to comment on the complaint, saying only that the agency's work is "carried out in accordance with a strict legal and policy framework which ensures that our activities are authorized, necessary and proportionate, and that there is rigorous oversight."


Lately, I can't stop myself from thinking about Sneetches. Remember them? As any young reader would love to tell you:

But for the life of me, I keep seeing Sneetches in terms of Republicans and Democrats.

2014, May 7 Bernie Sanders Asks Fed Chair Whether the US Is an Oligarchy

If the US Senate really is the world's greatest deliberative body, it ought to consider consequential questions. That does not happen often in a Senate where trivia tends too frequently to triumph over issues of substance. But [Senator Bernie Sanders](#), I-Vermont, [raised](#) what might just be the most substantial issue of all Wednesday, at a Joint Economic Committee hearing where Federal Reserve board chair Janet Yellen was testifying.

The senator began with the facts: "In the US today, the top 1 percent own about 38 percent of the financial wealth of America. The bottom 60 percent own 2.3 percent. One family, the Walton family, is worth over \$140 billion; that's more wealth than the bottom 40 percent of the American people. In recent years, we have seen a huge increase in the number of millionaires and billionaires, while we continue to have the highest rate of childhood poverty in the industrialized world. Despite, as many of my Republican friends talk about 'the oppressive Obama economic policies,' in the last year Charles and David Koch struggled under these policies and their wealth increased by \$12 billion in one year. In terms of income, 95 percent of new income generated in this country in the last year went to the top 1 percent."

Sanders then introduced an academic [study](#), by Martin Gilens and Benjamin Page, that [concludes](#), "The central point that emerges from our research is that economic elites and organized groups representing business interests have substantial independent impacts on US government policy, while mass-based interest groups and average citizens have little or no independent influence."

That sounds like an oligarchy.

So Sanders asked Yellen: "In your judgment, given the enormous power held by the billionaire class and their political representatives, are we still a capitalist democracy or have we gone over to an oligarchic form of society in which incredible enormous economic and political power now rests with the billionaire class?"

Yellen did not answer "yes." But she did [say](#), "There's no question that we've had a trend toward growing [inequality](#) and I personally find it a very worrisome trend that deserves the attention of policy makers."

She also expressed concern that trends toward growing inequality "can shape [and] determine the ability of

different groups to participate equally in a democracy and have grave effects on social stability over time.”

Sanders asked another question, as well: “There comes a point where the billionaire class has so much political power, where the Koch brothers are now because of *Citizens United* able to buy and sell politicians; they have so much political power, at what point is that reversible?”

The senator did not press Yellen for an answer to that question. And her responses to inquiries about Republican proposals to cut the estate tax and otherwise steer wealth upward suggested that the Fed chair believes Congress has policymaking duties in this regard.

Ultimately, questions about oligarchy come back to politics, something Sanders well understands. He’s been arguing that core question regarding the concentration of economic and political power need to be addressed not just by politicians but by voters—with choices made in 2014 and 2016. As he [explained](#) recently, “[This] country faces more serious problems than at any time since the Great Depression, and there is a horrendous lack of serious political discourse or ideas out there that can address these crises, and that somebody has got to represent the working-class and the middle-class of this country in standing up to the big-money interests who have so much power over the economic and political life of this country.”

The issues are so consequential, Sanders says, that he is thinking about mounting a presidential campaign that would ask the American people whether they want to live in an oligarchic form of society.

Russell Davies, another user, has explained why the alleged UFOs appear during night time.

“I see up to 12 of these a day in Shrewsbury UK, you can call them, they respond to telepathic communication. They generally appear at night in order to evade detection by a paranoid and largely hostile military,” Davies commented on the YouTube page.

“They are probes sent out from ET mother-ships, and are here simply to catalogue the state of the biosphere-earth and even to monitor human emotions, as well as behavior.”

In the past few years, number of UFO sightings is believed to have increased across the world.

A former CIA and civilian pilot has sworn an affidavit, stating that no planes flew into the Twin Towers as it would have been physically impossible.

John Lear, the son of **Learjet inventor, Bill Lear**, has given his expert evidence that it would have been physically impossible for Boeing 767s, like Flights AA11 and UA175 to have hit the Twin Towers on 9/11, particularly when flown by inexperienced pilots:

'No Boeing 767 airliners hit the Twin Towers as fraudulently alleged by the government, media, NIST and its contractors', he stated in the affidavit.

'Such crashes did not occur because they are physically impossible as depicted, for the following reasons: in the case of UAL 175 going into the south tower, a real Boeing 767 would have begun 'telescoping' when the nose hit the 14 inch steel columns which are 39 inches on center.

'The vertical and horizontal tail would have instantaneously separated from the aircraft, hit the steel box columns and fallen to the ground.

'The engines when impacting the steel columns would havemaintained their general shape and either fallen to the ground or been recovered in the debris of the collapsed building.

'No Boeing 767 could attain a speed of 540 mph at 1000 feet above sea level 'parasite drag doubles with velocity' and 'parasite power' cubes with velocity.

- **The fan portion of the engine is not designed to accept the volume of dense air at that altitude and speed.**
- **The piece of alleged external fuselage containing 3 or 4 window cutouts is inconsistent with an airplane that hit 14 inch steel box columns, placed at over 500 mph. It would have crumpled.**
- **No significant part of the Boeing 767 or engine could have penetrated the 14 inch steel columns and 37 feet beyond the massive core of the tower without part of it falling to the ground.**


'The debris of the collapse should have contained massive sections of the Boeing 767, including 3 engine cores weighing approximately 9000 pounds apiece which could not have been hidden. Yet there is no evidence of any of these massive structural components from either 767 at the WTC. Such complete disappearance of 767s is

impossible.

The affidavit, dated 28th January 2014 is part of a law suit being pursued by **Morgan Reynolds** in the United States District Court, Southern District, New York.

In March 2007, Reynolds, a former chief economist under the George W Bush administration filed a Request For Correction with the US National Institute of Science and Technology citing his belief that real commercial jets (Boeings) did not hit the WTC towers.

Although the 9/11 Truth movement initially rejected the 'no-planes' theory as too outlandish, after scientific and rational analysis, it has become a widely accepted explanation of the evidence collected.



Unlike any other form of statement, an affidavit becomes truth in law, if it is not rebutted. It will now be up to critics of the theory to present their evidence and analysis to rebut the statement point by point. If they do not – or cannot – then the US government will be obliged to admit that the account given by the 9/11 Commission is wrong.

The 65 year old retired airline captain and former CIA pilot – who has over 19,000 hours of flight time -- also drew attention to the inexperience of the pilots who allegedly flew the planes:
'The alleged 'controlled' descent into New York on a relatively straight course by a novice pilot is unlikely in the extreme because of the difficulty of controlling heading, descent rate and descent speed within the parameters of 'controlled' flight.

'It takes a highly skilled pilot to interpret the "EFIS" (Electronic Flight Instrument Display) display, with which none of the hijacker pilots would have been familiar or received training on, and use his controls, including the ailerons, rudder, elevators, spoilers and throttles to effect, control and maintain a descent.

Lear has, according to his sworn statement, flown over 100 different types of planes during his 40 years of flying and holds more FAA airman certificates than any other FAA certificated airman. He flew secret missions for the CIA in Southeast Asia, Eastern Europe, the Middle East and Africa between 1967 and 1983 then spent 17 years working for several passenger and cargo airlines as Captain, Check Airman and Instructor.

He is a member of Pilotsfor911truth.org, which has consistently shown that it was impossible for jet airliners to have hit the Twin Towers in the way the 9/11 Commission has suggested.

The Commission did not take evidence from experts or pilots when it conducted its enquiry into the attacks from 2002 to 2004.

2014, May 13 **NC teacher complains about inadequate pay--and gets pompous reply from NC state senator**

If you want to get an idea of what teachers in North Carolina have had to put up with since the Republicans took full control of state government, WUNC, the NPR member station for the Triangle, has [a lulu of an example](#).

Last week, Sarah Wiles, a science teacher from Charlotte, fired off an email to the entire North Carolina General Assembly which called for the legislature to back up its talk about how appreciated teachers are by increasing their pay. North Carolina, for those who don't know, is fourth from the bottom in the nation in average pay for its teachers. The state's teachers haven't had a raise in six years.

Yesterday, she got a reply from David Curtis, a state senator who represents some of Charlotte's northern suburbs near Lake Norman. In so many words, Curtis called Wiles an ingrate.

Since you naturally do not want to remain in a profession of which you are ashamed, here are my suggestions for what you should tell your potential new private sector employer:

1. You expect to make a lot more than you made as a teacher because everyone knows how poorly compensated teachers are.
2. You expect at least eight weeks paid vacation per year because that is what the taxpayers of North Carolina gave you back when you were a poorly compensated teacher
3. You expect a defined contribution retirement plan that will guarantee you about \$35,000 per year for life after working 30 years even if you live to be 104 years old. Your employer will need to put about \$16,000 per year into your retirement plan each year combined with your \$2,000 contribution for the next 30 years to achieve this benefit. If he objects, explain to him that a judge has ruled that the taxpayers of North Carolina must provide this benefit to every public school teacher. Tell him that may be true, but to keep that confidential because the teachers union has convinced parents that teachers are grossly undercompensated based on a flawed teachers union survey of teacher pay.

Curtis is not only a pompous jerk, but he's also wrong. For one thing, there is no "teachers union" in North Carolina. The state constitution bars state employees from bargaining collectively. Curtis was referring to the North Carolina Association of Educators, which is just a professional association--and one that only represents one-third of the state's teachers. Yet, it's pretty much an article of faith among North Carolina teabaggers that the NCAE is a union. Moreover, like most states, those eight weeks of vacation are unpaid--so teachers have to make 10 months of pay stretch out over an entire year.

Just for ha-ha's, I did some digging--and Curtis [is completely unopposed for reelection](#). His district is so red that it would be an extremely heavy lift for a Democrat in any event.
