Memberships run September to August. Members enjoy discounted fees, a newsletter, shared resources, and social events.

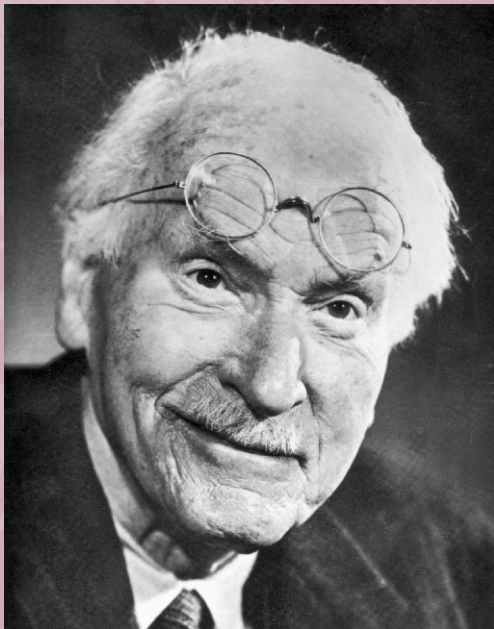
