The Certified Gang Professional Program (CGP) is not intended to make you an expert in the field of gangs. However, paired with experience, it will serve as one more resource in recognition as such; and reflects that you possess a standard of professional competency and knowledge in this area of specialization.

REQUIREMENTS

- Criminal Justice Employee
- Active member of a Gang Investigators Association
- Proof of attendance at an ECGIA recognized Gang Investigators Association training within a year prior to CGP testing (conference attendance at time of testing is acceptable)
- On-Site 'Gangs 101' course of instruction and successful testing completion

ADMINISTRATION

- Administration and facilitation will be provided by ECGIA members during the course of its annual conference, sponsored trainings and other posted events as advertised on its site: www.ecgia.org
- Issuance of a formal certificate upon successful completion

COST

- \$125 Initial Certification for a period of 3yrs:
- \$125 Recertification* (*requirements listed above except on-site gangs 101)
