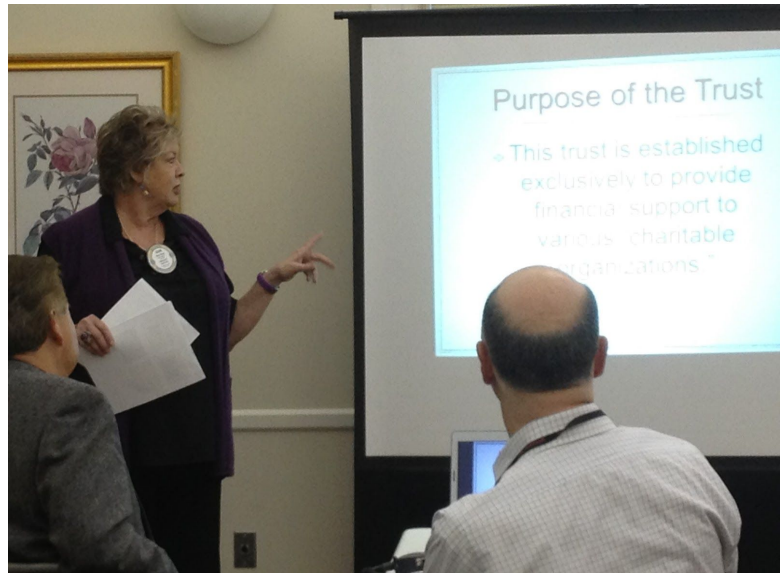
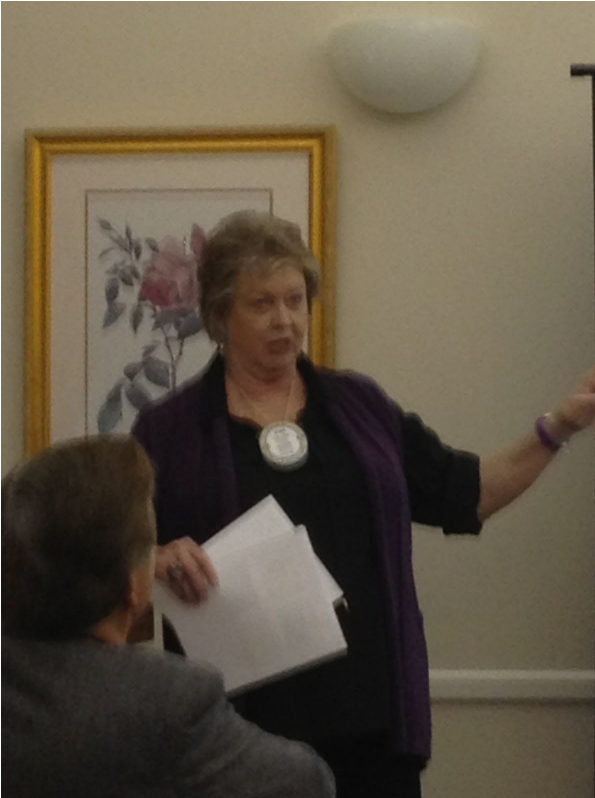

**Purpose of the Trust:** This Trust is established exclusively to provide financial support to various "charitable organizations".

The Trust is the 501(c)3 arm of our charitable giving. It is comprised of 7 Trustees, including the club President, President-Elect, Treasurer, and 4 at-large Trustees.

We raise several buckets of money throughout the year.

- The Happy Dollars and Fines are deposited to the Community Fund. \$500 of which can be used as an Emergency Fund without approval from the Board.
- The Annual Fundraising Activities including the Ball Pit, World Series Raffle, Super Bowl Raffle, Tour de Vines, monies are deposited to our Annual Giving which are granted to the community non-profits on Grant Day.
- Special Gifts and Bequests contributions are deposited to the Endowment. The funds are managed by Pinnacle Advisory.

Grants are awarded to 501(c)3 charities, following specific guidelines. Club members nominate the charities, the Community Service Lane evaluates and recommends the grants to the Trust, and finally, the Trust reviews and approves the grants.

On Grant Day, club president AJ, will hand over the check to the recipients.
