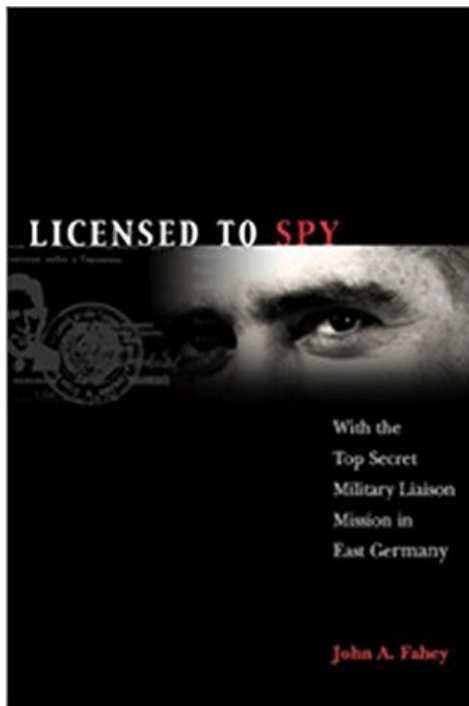
Only 3 grant requests have been submitted to date. Don't delay, submit your grants. We have approximately \$45,000 to distribute this year.

He was a Russian linguist in East Berlin during the Cold War. In 1946, after WWII, there was a policy to have more contact between the Soviets and the U.S. to keep the peace in Germany. He was fluent in Russian, and travelled throughout East Germany. He was caught twice as a spy, but was so knowledgeable about Russia, that he was able to talk himself out of captivity. He surrendered about 12 times during the Cold War. He used photography to collect intelligence. His wife lived in West Berlin, and he would travel back and forth.

Regarding the current situation, he would like to have more military to military communications between Russia and the U.S. You need to know your enemy.
