So far, we have profited over \$8,000.

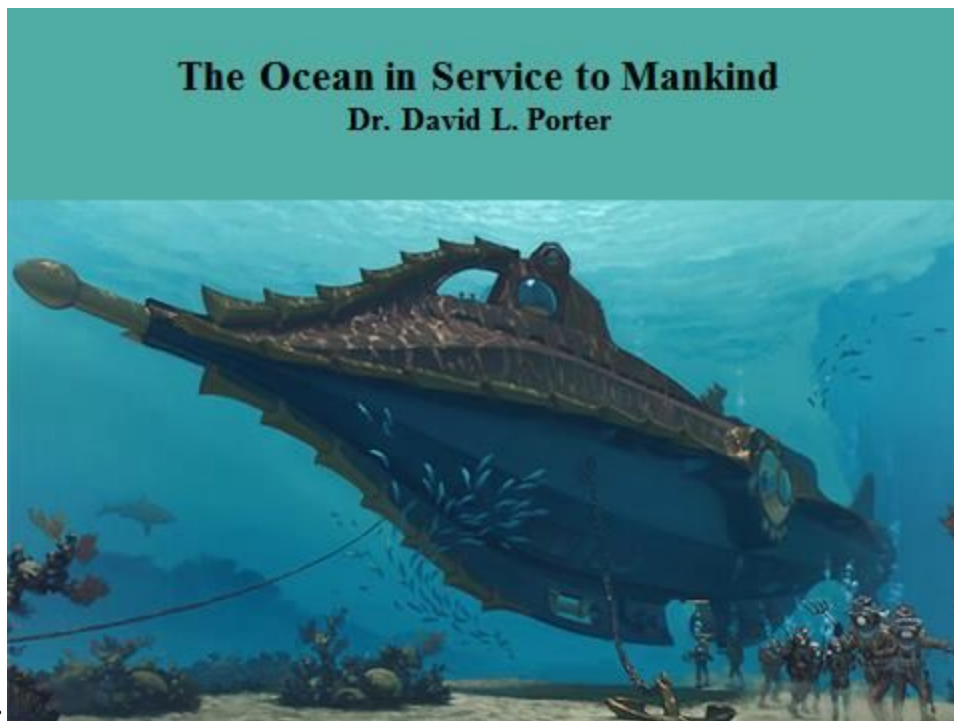

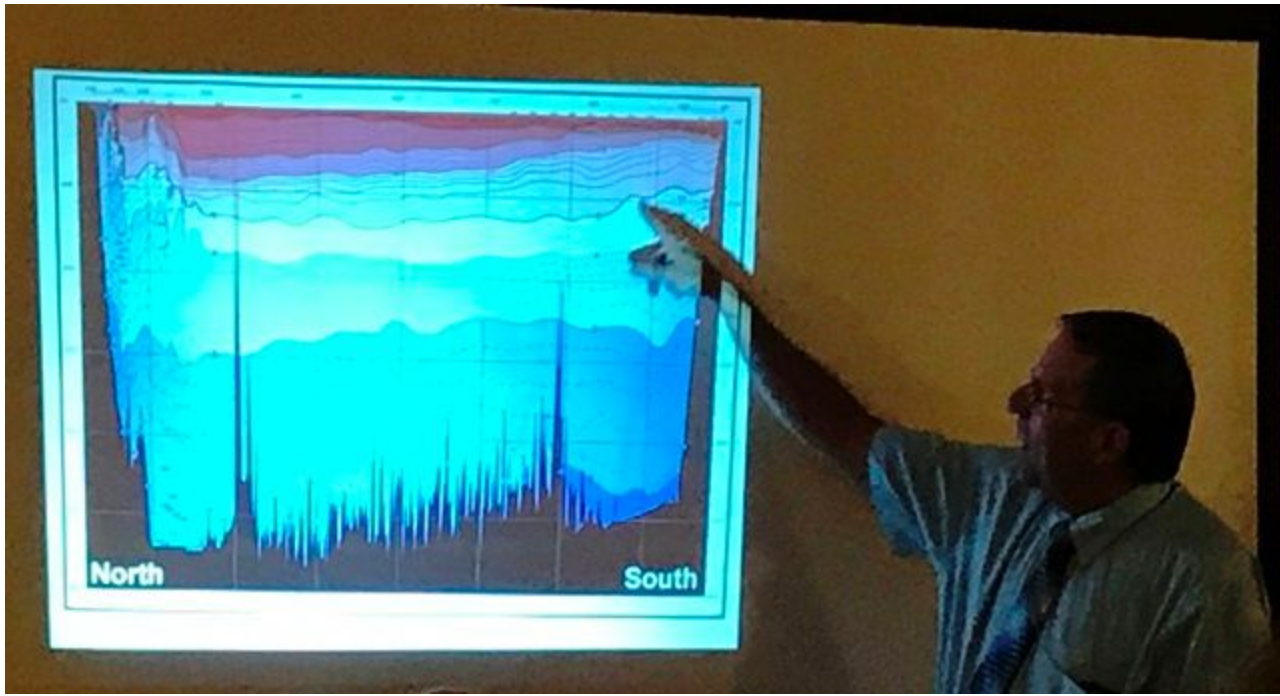
