Beekeeping in Howard County with Doris Walsh, Bee Ambassador



A self described "Nature Girl", Doris will entertain you with stories of beekeeping in Howard County, raising monarch butterflies, and a few "bee rescues" as she hopes to entice you to increase your intake of Vitamin N (for nature).

The color of honey is determined by the nectar collected. Bees are fuzzy with a golden hue. Wasps, including yellow jackets, are black and yellow, and not fuzzy.

33% of the bites of food we consume comes from plants pollinated by bees. In early spring, bees love dandelions.

There is only one Queen bee, and many Drone bees, and Worker bees. Bees have Age Polyethism which means that they go through stages in life with different duties and responsibilities.
