### **Blaine Milner:**

Grade Schooler Blaine Milner rode to school on a pony in the rural farmlands of the Kansas, just after Kansas achieved statehood status. Polio patients were treated by being placed in an iron lung. It affected children and adults. President FDR was paralyzed by polio. He started the March of Dimes fundraiser to treat polio. His face is on the dime. (FDR's not Blaine's).

There are 3 reported cases of polio this year, worldwide.

### **Tom Allen:**

Heroin addiction is an epidemic in Maryland. Typically, it starts with prescription pain medication, percocet, vicodin, oxycontin. Heroin is the same base opioid drug. People can become addicted to the opioid drug, and turn to street drugs, like heroin.

Some suggestions to avoid drug addiction:

1. There are usually better medicine choices than narcotics for pain management.
1. Take the meds for shorter duration
2. Keep the meds out of reach of others, especially kids
3. Dispose of the unused meds properly. Bring them to the local depository at the police stations. Don't flush them down the toilet.
