Here is a little bit of our story:

My wife Sue and I have been married over 30 years and have three adult children. In 2004 we received a dramatic call to leave our home, church, family and careers and move to Israel. I am a Jewish believer and had at one time prepared for overseas missionary service but the call to Israel was a dramatic surprise to both Sue and I. We were both in our 40s and were moving into that time of middle age when folks usually look to settle down and consolidate their lives. Quite unexpectedly, the Holy Spirit dramatically spoke to us to leave it all behind, trust Him to guide us and follow Him on a new, unknown adventure.

Within a year of that initial call we were on our way to Israel, not as foreign missionaries but as citizens. In these last days God has promised to gather the Jewish people back from the 4 corners of the world – back to the Land of Israel and back to the King and Messiah of Israel, Yeshua of Nazareth.



Shortly after our move, I was welcomed by Eitan Shishkoff, the leader of Tents of Mercy, to join the ministry team of this dynamic work in Northern Israel (please see our website: www.tents-of-mercy.org). I now serve as the International Liaison and editor of our magazine, Israel's Restoration/ Oasis. The Lord led Sue in a very wonderful way through her love of horses. She enrolled in a therapeutic riding course (in Hebrew) and has since been hired as a therapeutic riding instructor for a large orphanage. Sue combines her practical know how and gentle ways to bring healing to some of Israel's most troubled children.

I have many duties but I am especially charged to build relations between Tents of Mercy and believers throughout the nations whom God has stirred to connect with our ministry. Since joining our ministry I have had the amazing privilege of sharing God's heart for Israel with believers from all over the world. Every summer for the last 5 years I have traveled to various countries, helping God's people catch His heart for Israel as it fits into His covenant purposes for the whole world.

What God is doing at Tents of Mercy is beyond the scope of what we can achieve on our own. There is a clear scriptural principle that the promised restoration of Israel is achieved through joint partnership between believers in Israel and believers in the nations. This blessing is not just for Israel. As we are restored we in turn enter our calling to be a blessing to the nations. My task here at Tents of Mercy is to facilitate that partnership.
