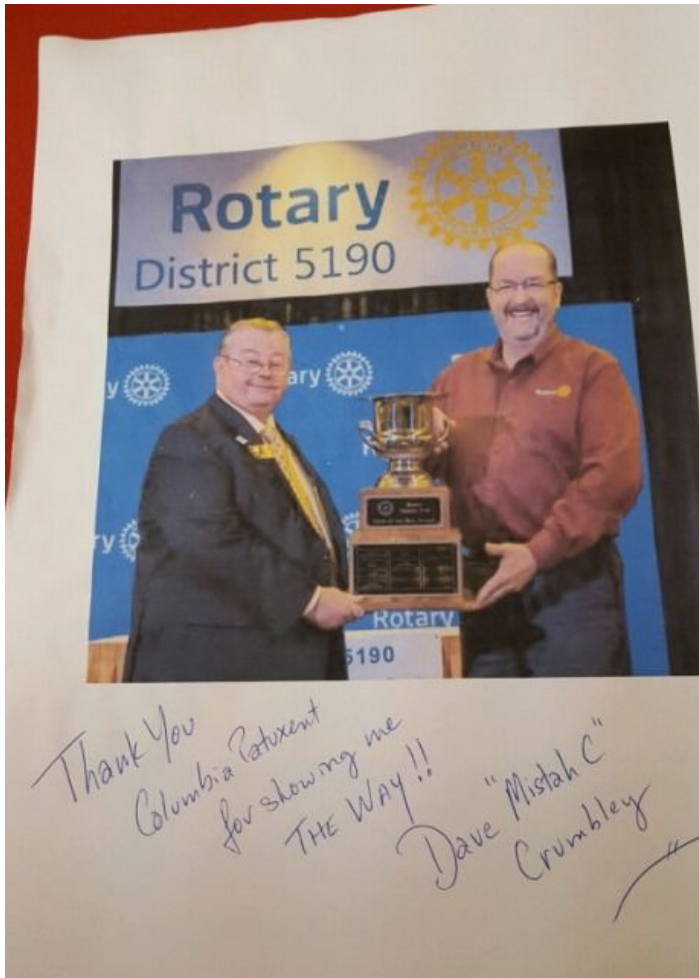
**Happy Dollars:**
